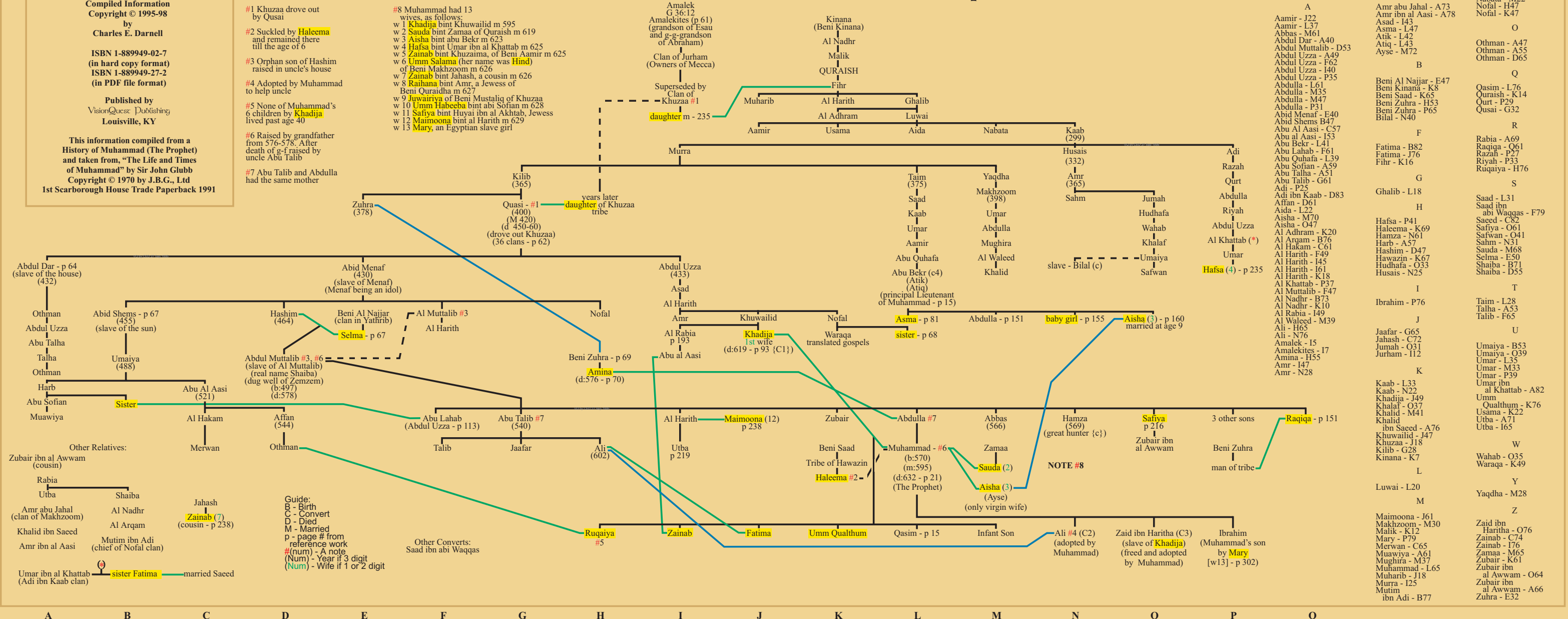

- #6 Raised by grandfather from 576-578. After death of g-f raised by uncle Abu Talib
- #7 Abu Talib and Abdulla had the same mother

 - w 9 Juwairiya of Beni Mustalig of Khuzaa
 - w 10 Umm Habeeba bint abi Sofian m 628
 - w 11 Safiyya bint Huyai ibn al Akhtab, Jewess
 - w 12 Maimoona bint al Harith m 629
 - w 13 Mary, an Egyptian slave girl
